- 4. Fundraising, **Shivani**: April 9th will be Anthony Coal Fired fundraiser, with offer 20% return on purchases. **Sangeetha's** 2nd email push re: Giftcards was quite successful, with a total of \$4700 worth of giftcards purchased. **Gail** will send final email reminder, as this round of sales will end on 3/10. BB board members will help distribute giftcards. **Shivani** is planning a future ice cream shop fundraiser.
- 5. Website/Secretary, Jeff, Gail: Jeff is exploring free email/website options (nonprofit Google and DreamHost).
- 6. Snacks, **Sangeetha**, **Sonia**: on COVID hiatus
- 7. Pit/Bus/Tech, **Greg:** Bus key is held by Gabe, in Transportation. Tractor will need to be repaired or replaced.
- 8. Old Business: **Shelli** will need help identifying seniors in senior photos.
- 9. New Business: Need slate of new officers/committee chairs. Especially needed are replacement Snack and Secretary positions. New members needed, next year more "Senior" parents are leaving. **Gail** will send out appeal letter 3/11. Valedictorian (Rosa) is a MB pit member. Salutatorian (Kevin) was 2-year band member.

- a. No in-person Jazz or Concert Band performances on calendar; awaiting updates in May.

- h. Marching Band 2021 theme will be SUNSHINE (for positivity). BB are requested by directors to potentially provide money for copyright licenses, flags and some of the costumes/scenery (approximately a \$2500-\$3000 request).
- i. Senior dinner may be an outdoor picnic; TBD in May.
- j. Directors' scholarship decisions can be discussed at April Meeting. 23 Seniors could apply.
- k. Marching band will replace guard assistant and add a percussion assistant (will now have 1 for pit and 1 for battery). Budget approved by town.
